The team at Aghadoe Heights Hotel & Spa is dedicated to providing a more responsible and eco-friendly environment. We have changed the way we use resources and we have created a number of sustainable approaches to ensure that we are consistently improving and minimising any negative effect our procedures or systems have on the environment. Communicating this policy to our employees, suppliers and guests is a high priority for us here at Aghadoe.

- We believe in sourcing and buying responsibly. This includes purchasing from local suppliers, reducing food miles and supporting local businesses.

This is part of our continuing commitment to reduce our food miles and to always provide the very best local and Irish produce.
- We have agreed to achieve certification from The Green Hospitality Programme which is one of the only environmental certification standards for the Hospitality Industry.
- We have Green Champions among our team striving to achieve and implement our goals with colleagues & train them on our sustainable practices.
- We have our own herb garden lovingly cared for by our gardener.
- We offer four EV charging points onsite.
- We are up to 90% conversion to LED lighting across the hotel.
- We have designed a training programme for our kitchen department on reducing food waste.
- We are replacing single use plastic straws with re-usable alternatives.
- We compost waste to create compost for our garden, including a herb garden for our chefs.
- Plastic, cardboard, glass and dry recyclying is all collected seperately for recycling.
- We have dedicated Biodiversity Areas across our five acres of land.

Local Tours & Attractions

THINGS TO DO AND SEE

The following tours can be arranged by contacting reception or our head concierge.

The Ring of Kerry A panoramic drive through some of Kerry's most outstanding scenery around the Iveragh Peninsula that provides an ever changing landscape over it's hundred miles. The route travels through Killorglin by the banks of the River Laune, Caragh Lake and on to Glenbeigh where you get your first glimpse of the Atlantic at Rossbeigh. The route then moves along the southern shores of Dingle Bay to Kells, south of Caherciveen where Valentia Island comes into view and then on to Ballinskelligs. From there you continue to Waterville and along the coast to Coomakista Pass and Derrynane to Sneem. From Sneem you travel along the northern shore of Kenmare Bay until you come to Kenmare itself. Finally the route return to Killarney via Moll's Gap and Ladies' View from which there are breathtaking views of the three lakes. There are shorter routes for those who do not want to do the complete circuit in one day.

Killarney Local Circuit Points of interest on the route include the ruins of Aghadoe, Gap of Dunloe, Ross Castle, Muckross House & Gardens, Torc Waterfall, the Middle & Upper Lakes and Eagle's Nest Mountain.

Caragh Lake & Rossbeigh Route via Glencar and Caragh Lake to Rossbeigh and return via Killorglin.

Dingle & Slea Head Travelling via Miltown and Castlemaine to the beach and sandhills of Inch. Continuing along the coast to Dingle where a stop can be made for lunch. On to Slea Head where one can view the three Blaskets and famous Brandon Hill. Returning home via Aunascaul and the Vale of Tralee.

Loo Valley & Glengarriff Along the river Flesk passing the Killaha Castle stronghold of the Irish Chieftan "O'Donoghue of the Glen" on through the Loo Valley to Kilgarvan and Glengarriff. Stop for lunch and then take a boat to Garnish Island. The return journey home takes you over the mountains through Wynn's Tunnels to Kenmare and then to Killarney via Moll's Gap, the Upper Lake and Muckross.

Cork & Blarney Castle From Killarney the route embraces Macroom and the rolling hinterland of County Cork leading to the world famous Blarney Castle where adequate time should be allowed to visit the demesne and kiss the "Stone of Eloquence". On to Cork for lunch and the return journey encompasses the Gaelic speaking area of Ballyvourney and the picturesque banks of the River Flesk.

Beara Peninsula Split and shared between Cork and Kerry counties, this fine coastland has some of the most outstanding beauty spots of the south west of Ireland. From Killarney follow the Kenmare road via Moll's Gap and from Kenmare continue on to Tuosist, Lauragh, Ardgroon, Eyeries, Adrigole and Glengarriff and return again back to Killarney via Kenmare.

Gap Of Dunloe Travel from Killarney by traditional jaunting car to Kate Kearney's Cottage. From here, if you are feeling energetic, you can walk 7 miles to the shore of the Upper Lake at Gaerhameen, or relax in a pony and trap and enjoy the magnificent views en route. Enjoy a picnic lunch, which can be ordered from the hotel, amidst the finest scenery in the world. Afterwards, the Gap boats will take you through the long range to the "Meeting of the Waters". Here you can shoot the rapids and travel on through Lough Leane to Ross Castle. From here transport can be arranged to bring you back to the hotel.
